

OUR COLLEGE

RAJAPALAYAM RAJUS' COLLEGE was established on 22nd June 1973. The 52 acre site is situated on the northern side of the Mudangiar Road leading to the Ayyanar Temple. The college was established from the Palayapalayam Rajus Mahumai Fund, an endowment that keeps contributing towards the development of the College. The College offers 12 Under Graduate and 5 Post Graduate courses in Arts and Sciences and has Research Centres in History and Commerce.

LIBRARY

Dr.D.Regupathy Raja Memorial Library has over 33,750 books, 500CDs and subscribes to 8 newspapers, 25 periodicals and through NLIST-INFLIBNET to 6 Lakh+ e-books and 6000+ e-journals. The library has a rich collection of 2,000+ resources in the Reference Section, maintains a Book Bank exclusively for marginalized students and offers Career Guidance as well. Important days are observed and numerous competitions are conducted regularly.
