Plan of Action	Achievements
To enhance the laboratory facilities.	Equipment were purchased for Physics and Chemistry Laboratories.
To appeal the College Governing Council to construct girls' hostel.	Construction of girls' hostel has commenced.
To provide bus facility for girl students.	New bus for girl students' was purchased.
To construct a separate lunch shed for girl students.	Lunch shed has been constructed at a cost of Rs. 7,51,306.
To enhance research output and to motivate the teaching faculty to publish more research articles in peer reviewed, high impact journals.	27 research scholars are pursuing Ph.D programmes in the Departments of History, Commerce and Tamil. There has been an increase in the number of publications in international and national peer reviewed journals. Google Scholar and Scopus Citations increased to 47.
To organize Gender Sensitization programmes.	Gender Sensitization programmes were conducted periodically.
To encourage sports activities in the campus.	Sports equipment were purchased for Rs. 8.1 lakhs. Mr. S. Mariselvam participated at National Level Athletics Event held at NewDelhi. Madurai Kamaraj University 'D' Zone Volley Ball Tournament was organized by the Department of Physical Education. 43 rd Annual Sports Meet was conducted. 350 Prizes and Certificates were distributed to winners.

Career oriented training courses / Certificate courses should be given to students.	Certificate and Short-term courses were conducted by many Departments. A separate list is enclosed.
To enhance placement of students through Campus Interview.	Students were placed through campus interview organized by the Placement Cell. A separate list is enclosed.
To conduct remedial coaching classes.	Remedial coaching classes were conducted for academically weaker students.
To digitize and computerize library services.	Library activities have been computerized with the help of library management system software ROVAN. All the books have been bar-coded.
To inspire the extension activities.	Several social services and social awareness programmes were rendered through NCC, NSS, YRC, RRC and Blood Donors Club. NSS camps were conducted at villages. About 145 units of blood were donated. Various Disaster Management Programmes were organized by YRC. 'Best NSS Programme Officer Award' was received by Mr. R. Jaganath, NSS Programme Officer from Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai in this year.
To install CCTV cameras to enhance the security of students.	CCTV cameras were installed in all buildings.
