



**A) Gender**




***Among the 856 student respondents 59% are males while 40.7% are females.***


## B) What degree program you are pursuing now?



## C) What subject area are you currently pursuing?




### 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




*Out of 856 students 221 (25.8%) said that 70-84% of the syllabus was covered in the class while 574 (67.1 %) students said that 85-100% of the syllabus was covered in the class.*

### 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?




*Out of 856 students 307 (35.9%) students confirmed that teachers prepared thoroughly for the class, 477 (55.7 %) said teachers prepared satisfactorily while 28 (3.3 %) said they were indifferent.*

### 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




*Out of 856 students 540 (63.1%) said that the teachers were always able to communicate effectively, 191 (22.5%) said that they were sometimes effective while 12 (1.4%) said teachers were very poor in communication.*

### 4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




*Out of 856 students 348 (40.7 %) said that the teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as excellent, 295 (34.5%) said it was very good, 197 (23%) said Good, 11(1.3%) said fair while 5 (0.6 %) said it was poor.*

### 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




*In all 440 students (51.4%) confirmed that the internal evaluation by the teachers was always Fair while 278(32.5%) said that they were usually Fair.*

### 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?




*Of the 856 students 420(49.1%) students confirmed that their performance in assignments were every time discussed with them, 315(35.60%) said usually and 21(2.5%) said never.*

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




*Among the 856 student respondents 463 (54.1%) said that the institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities regularly, 163 (19%) said often while 149 (17.4%) said sometimes.*

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.




*When asked whether the teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates in cognitive, social and emotional growth, 378 (44.2%) respondents said very well, 342(40%) said significantly, 86 (10%) said moderately, 24 (2.8%) marginally and 26( 3%) not at all.*

9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow




*Of the 856 students 414(48.4%) agreed that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow, 327(36.73%) strongly agreed, 84(10%) were neutral, 22 (2%) disagreed while 9 ( 1.09%)strongly disagreed.*

10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes




*When asked whether the teachers informed about expected competencies, course outcome and programme outcomes 416 respondents ( 48.6%) said every time, 334 respondents (39%)said usually and 59 (6.9%) said occasionally/sometimes.*

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.




*Out of the 856 students 405( 47.71%)students said that their mentor every time follows up the assigned task, 327( 28.02%) said usually and 74( 8.6%)said occasionally.*

12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




*A majority of 434 (50.7%) students said that their teacher illustrates the concepts through examples and applications while 305 (35.6%) said usually.*

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




*Of the 856 respondents, a majority of 481 (56.2%) students said that their teachers identify their strengths and encourage them with providing right level of challenges fully and 264 (30.8%) said reasonably.*

14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.




*Of the 856 student respondents, 452 (52.8%) students said that teachers were able to identify their weakness and help to overcome them every time and 265 (31%) said usually*

15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




*Of the 856 student respondents a majority of 389(45.4%) agreed that the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality, 359(41.9%) strongly agreed while 7(0.82%) strongly disagreed.*

16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences




*Among the 856 respondents a majority of 426 (49.81%) students confirmed that the institute /teachers use student centric methods such as experiential learning, participative learning to a great extent and 278 (32.57%) said they moderately used.*

17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.





18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.





19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.




*Of the 856 student respondents 324 (37.99 %) students 315 (36.8%) confirmed that 70-89%, 128(15%) said 50-69%.*

## 21. Quality of the programmes offered in the College?





## 22. Faculty Support for your continuous academic growth?





**23. Library and laboratory facilities available in the campus promotes your academic pursuit**




